

Flipped Classroom Lesson Plan

A lesson partially prepared by second graders and partially by a teacher.

School: I Liceum Ogólnokształcące im. Jana Śniadeckiego

Teacher: Marta Strzelczyk

Lesson Title: Passive Voice – introduction.

Subject Area(s): The introduction of Passive Voice – the use, the way of changing active sentences into passive ones, practice.

Grade Level: the second grade of high school

Time Needed: Home: 15 minutes

Class: 45 minutes

Learning objectives:

- Understanding the importance of Passive Voice in English,
- Knowing the use of PV,
- Noticing which sentence is in active and which one is in passive,
- Making sentences, changing from active to passive.

Student's Learning Resources at Home:

A computer,
Internet Access
A presentation sent by the teacher

Brief Description of Activity:

1. 3 minutes: A teacher checks the register and gives the topic of the lesson.
2. 10 minutes: On the basis of the presentation sent by the teacher students discuss the importance of the passive voice, how they understand it, what the purpose of using it is; they give examples of the sentences in Polish (because some students have the problem with understanding it in their native language).

3. 10 minutes: the students compare sentences in active and passive voice, they try to find the way of creating the passive sentences; next, the teacher shows and explains how to make a sentence in PV;
4. 10 minutes: Students listen to songs in which they can find examples of the PV, they write the examples down; they read what they found;
5. 10 minutes: The students do an exercise for PV – they need to change active into passive; 2 minutes: The teacher recaps the lesson with the students: they are to say what they remember from the class, they are given the homework in their students' books.
